

## **TRANSPORTATION DAY PLANNED AT ANDOVER LIBRARY AND PARK**

Andover's Public Library and Central Park will be overrun with airplanes, military vehicles, radio controlled cars and helicopters, antique cars and trains from 10 am to 3 pm, Saturday, August 7.

The Trains, Planes & Automobiles event is sponsored by the Andover Public Library Friends in association with 15 organizations, businesses and individuals. Among the participants are: Vietnam-era convoy truck, UH-1 and jeep from the Kansas Museum of Military History; model planes from Kansas Aviation Museum; radio-controlled cars from Derby; and antique cars from El Dorado.
