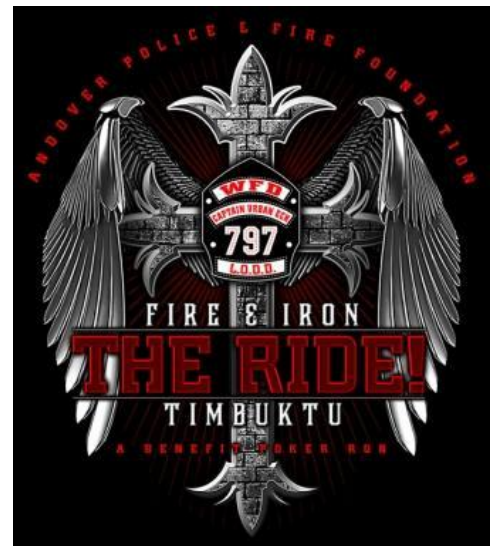

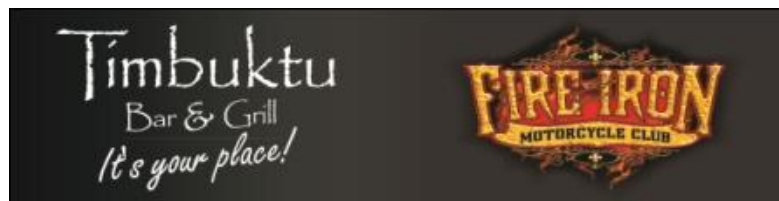
Together, we bring you The Ride! For The Bold – The Brave – The Big Hearts!
